With the ETSU Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD)-Master of Business Administration (MBA) dual degree program, gain a broader perspective on the business side of pharmacy across various health care settings. Degree offered through ETSU Bill Gatton College of Pharmacy and the College of Business and Technology.

Eligibility

Required:

- Bachelor's degree or higher (Gatton's bachelor's completion program is an option)
- Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) may be required

Application

Submit by **March 1 of P1 year** to Student Affairs:

- MBA program application available at etsu.edu/pharmacy/departments/pharmd_mba.php
- Application Fee paid to the School of Graduate Studies
- Personal essay of 150-300 words explaining reasons for pursuing PharmD-MBA program

Requirements

- 3 courses (9 credit hours), B or better in PharmD curriculum, serving as BADM electives and BADM stats course
- 9 courses (27 credit hours) within MBA program.
- Online MBA "boot camp" may be required for BADM courses
